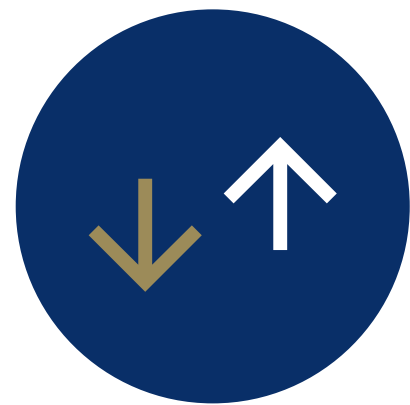

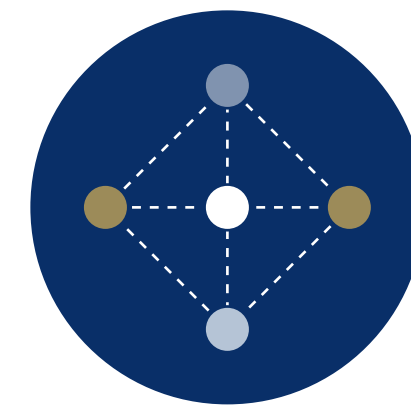
International faculty

History

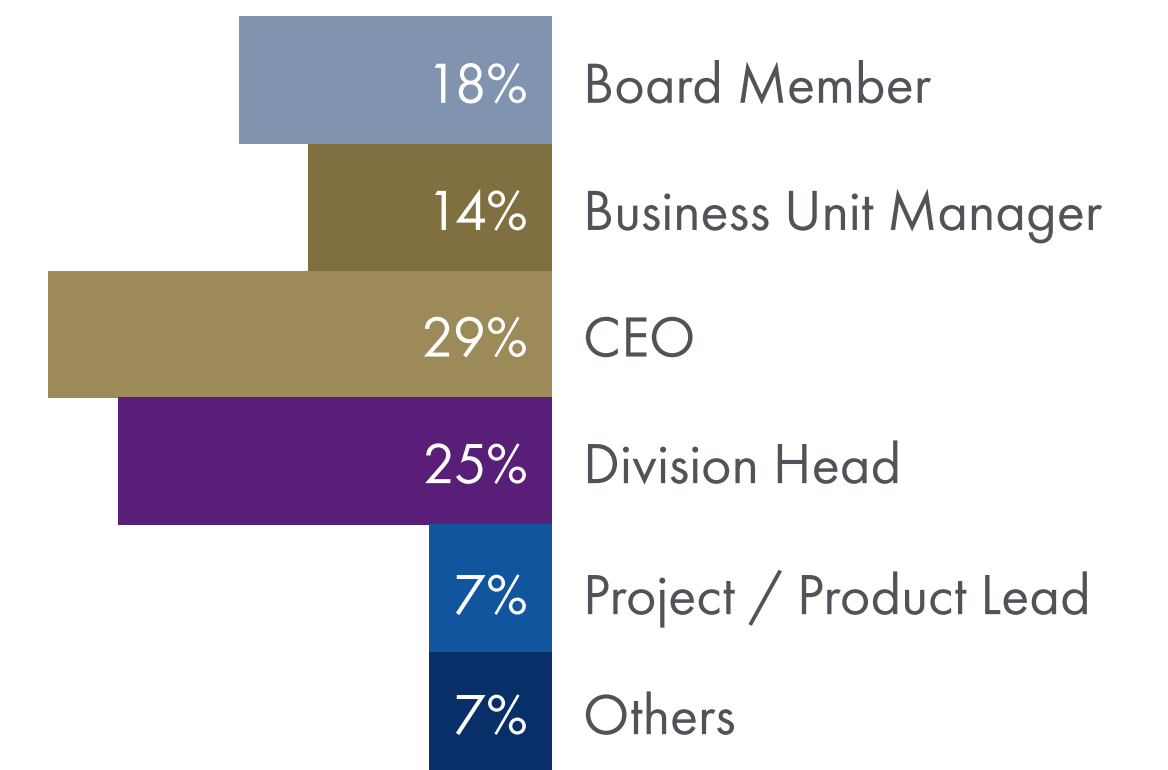

Application and admission

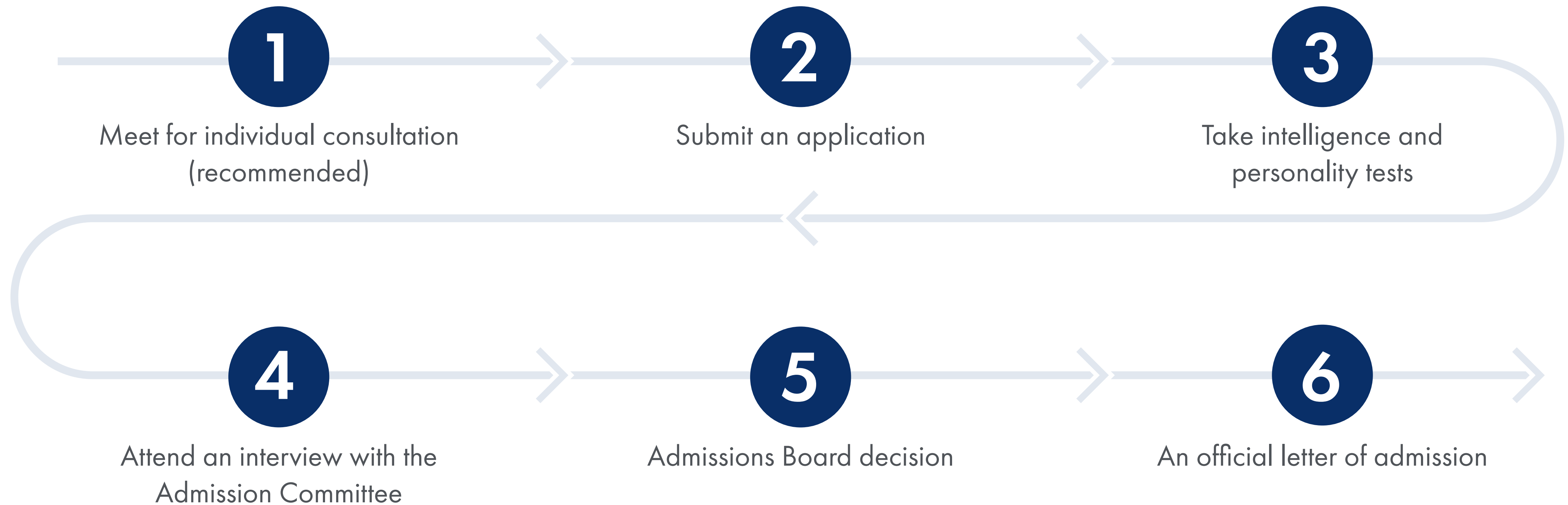
The programme starts once a year in September.
