

*** Complies if the secondary education certificate includes an assessment of English language skills, which are comparable to at least level B2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). EU countries: Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, The Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, and Sweden. EEA and Swiss Confederation: Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, and Switzerland.

Candidates who will graduate from secondary school by Summer 2025 will have to provide the final secondary school transcript and state exam results in English and mathematics (when applicable) before starting the studies. All candidates will need to show the originals of provided documents when signing the study agreement.
